Objectives of the project

- To provide academic and practical analysis of the provisions of the Regulation;
- To disseminate information on the Regulation among legal practioners (notaries, judges and private lawyers) in order to raise their awareness as to the changes introduced by the Regulation;
- To provide training and best practice exchange in relation to the current practice and future application of the provisions of the Regulation.

Evaluation of the project

- 4. Preparation of the questionnaire on successions and development of the database

Conclusions of the mid-term evaluation

- the evaluated main activities were successfully completed
- the website of the project was created, fully operational, user-friendly, complete and updated;
- the first two events attracted a big number of participants and were highly rated
 - a number of practical cases were identified and discussed that feeds into the practice paper to be produced towards the end of the project
 - related materials are freely available on the project web site.
