EU Regulation n. 650/12 entered into force on 16 August 2012.

It applies to the succession of persons who die on or after 17 August 2015.





The Regulation is directly applicable to Member States.

It is binding for 25 of the 27 European Union Member States, with the exclusion of Ireland and Denmark.





- Unity of succession.
- Coordination between national legal systems.
- Preference for succession planning.





The law applicable to the succession as a whole is the one of the State in which the deceased had his **habitual residence** at the time of death.





- Issuing authority.

- Subjects who may use the certificate.
