Privacy policy statement. This information is provided in compliance with Article 13 of the (EU) General Data Protection Regulation concerning the protection of natural persons, with reference to the processing of their personal data and the circulation of such data (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation"). Fondazione Italiana del Notariato, with registered office in Rome, Via Flaminia 160, e-mail: fondazionenotariato@notariato.it (hereinafter referred to as "FIN" or the "Controller") is the Controller. Your data shall be processed by using proper paper, electronic, and/or telematic tools, for the purposes listed below only, so as to guarantee the data security and confidentiality. **Categories of personal data.** FIN shall only collect data for purposes related to the participation in the training course, or to the selection, as well as for any other purpose that may be directly related to the aforesaid processing and/or with FIN's core activities. FIN shall only collect biographical data (including name, surname, date and place of birth, Tax code, place of residence), as well as education-related data. Furthermore, your CV shall be required for the purposes listed below. **Purpose and legal bases of the processing** *a. For the provision of the requested services.* The data provided in the registration form or in your participation application shall be processed by the Controller in order to allow you to register and participate in the selection. Hence, your data shall be processed in the framework of the legal relations with the Controller. *b. To fulfil regulatory obligations.* The data provided in the form shall be processed by the Controller in order to fulfil all regulatory obligations, including obligations provided for by the laws or by the relevant implementing regulations, by FIN's Bylaws, by the EU legislation, and by any order of any Authority entitled to issue orders by the law. **Categories of entities to which the personal data may be disclosed, and purposes of such disclosure.** The Controller may disclose, for the same purposes, part of your personal data to third parties, which shall process your personal data in their capacity as Processors. You may ask the Controller for the Processors list. **Data storage time and duration of processing.** Your data shall be stored for the whole selection time. Afterwards, your data shall only be kept for the time required to protect the Controller's rights, and for the fulfilment of the relevant legal obligations (for a maximum of 10 years as from the end of the selection). **Rights of the data subjects.** Please be informed that, pursuant to the laws and regulations in force, you have the following rights: the right to get confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning you is being stored by the Controller, and having access to such data; for the data processed electronically, asking and obtaining in a structured, commonly used format, which shall be readable by an automated device, your personal data held by the Controller, and ask it to be transferred to a different Controller; The right to obtain the updating and/or the rectification of your data, should you deem it inaccurate or incomplete; the right to obtain the erasure and/or to restrict the processing of your personal data, should such data not be or no longer be necessary for the purposes listed above, or after the end of the period referred to in the previous paragraph. In order to exercise his/her rights, the data subject can contact FIN. FIN's contact details are provided above. Please, be informed that, under the existing laws, you may file any complaint with the Italian data protection Watchdog (*Garante per la protezione dei dati personali*) with reference to the processing of your personal data.
