Fondazione Italiana del Notariato (Coordinator) and the partners Cassa Nazionale del Notariato, Notary Chamber of Bulgaria, Notary Chamber of Hungary and International Association of Judges have been awarded a grant under the "Action grants to support transnational projects on judicial training covering civil law, criminal law or fundamental rights" co-funded by the European Commission Justice Programme under the project "EUlawInEN - EU law training in English language: blended and integrated content and language training for European notaries and judges".

The project will last two years and the objective is to provide training sessions to notaries and judges on EU law, in particular Family and Succession related EC Regulations (650/2012, 1103/2016, 1104/2016 – and issues) in English – adopting the Content and Language Integrated Learning (C.L.I.L.) methodology, which particularly effective to this regard.

The project includes a ToT (Train of Trainers) course that will be held in Rome from 18 to 22 March 2019 for 12 participants of whom 6 judges and 6 notaries from three project partners' countries. They will be selected following an open call - published today on the project website - and will become trainers themselves.

Some preparatory activities for the trainers foresee one webinar and several online materials.

After the ToT, the 12 trainers will deliver two seminars and exchanges of best practices in each partner country to 24 professionals as to replicate the ToT model and make sure that the C.L.I.L methodology is applied in a consistent manner.

The dissemination of scientific and linguistic content to all notaries and judges of the involved countries will also be provided at distance through:

- •1 e-learning course of 20h as self-learning tool uploaded and available on a MOOC platform.
- •1 e-learning serious game with case studies dealing with the subjects addressed in the project
- •1 Handbook with EU law content and terminology in English as well as some examples of methodologies to apply to the training sessions through the C.L.I.L. didactic modality.

All the activities will be free of charge for notaries and judges in the three countries.
