Identified in the prospective circles which are direct toward and in turn come from the “source” European Union. “Plus” as an approach in a project that is the fruit of a successful and further developed shared experience.

The Seminar is the first one of the EC - DG Justice funded Project “Integration, migration, transnational relationships. Governing inheritance statutes after the entry into force of EU succession regulations -GoInEU Plus”.

The speakers will analyse the issues related with the application of EU Regulations on Successions and on Family Property Regimes, as well as some specific judicial cases, from, for instance, the Court of Justice of the European Union and the European Court of Human Rights. The Conference will encompass an Open Debate with participants from Universities and Legal Professions of Spain and Portugal, as well as from other Partner Countries, but also from Associations and European as well as Local Institutions. The main subjects to be discussed are: relationships between EU Regulation on Successions (n° 650/2012) and the new Regulations on Family Property Regimes (n° 1103/2016 and n° 1104/2016); application in Spain and Portugal of the EU Successions Regulation (n° 650/2012); new transnational families; the role of the law before diverse family models between party autonomy and protection of the weaker party; polygamy; prenuptial agreements; successions law and cryptocurrencies; renvoi and the conflict-of-laws rules; European Certificate of Succession. A special focus will be put on practical cases, also during the debate.

To the participants is given the opportunity to present written communications that will not be presented orally and may be published, with the approval of the Scientific Committee, in the Revista Actualidad Jurídica Iberoamericana, published by the Instituto de Derecho Iberoamericano.

The **GENERAL OBJECTIVE** of the action is to contribute to a coherent application of Family & Successions Regulations through analytical and capacity building activities targeting legal practitioners.

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES:

1. Contribute to the reduction of social conflicts promoting an analysis of the impact of Migration to EU Family & Successions Law regarding:

(I) marriage laws stemming from other cultural traditions; (II) alien contractual schemes on Family Property; (III) discrimination connected to different degrees of recognition of family models; (IV) non-judicial family break-ups; (V) protection of weaker parties in family break-ups; (VI) reconciling European Laws with religious dimensions of family in other cultural traditions.

2. Capacitate legal practitioners to handle issues linked to Migration to promote integration.

PLANNED ACTIVITIES:

(I) publication of peer-reviewed scientific papers and practical guidelines; (II) development of training content for sessions in presence and e-learning course on MOOC platform; (III) M&E and dissemination.

TARGET GROUPS:

Direct beneficiaries: notaries (40%), lawyers (30%), judges (10%), public officers (10%), academics (10%).

Indirect beneficiaries: EU citizens. In 2015, migrants to EU Member States were 4.7 million.

EXPECTED RESULTS:

(I) uniform application of EU law; (II) professionals much more trained to handle family & successions issues connected to Migration; (III) avoiding discrimination; (IV) reduction of social conflicts.

OUTPUTS:

(I) Questionnaire and Assessment Report; (II) e-learning course; (III) a book, scientific papers and practical guidelines; (III) 2 seminars, 2 conferences; (IV) project website; (V) updated database; (VI) evaluation reports; (VII) EC reports.
