➤ General Objective:

contribute to correct and coherent application of Successions Regulation through analytical and capacity building activities targeting legal practitioners.

➤ Specific Objectives:

- 1. analyze the impact of Successions Regulation in its first years of application with regard to: **(i)** migrant families; **(ii)** family models with different degrees of recognition in Member States; **(iii)** relationships with the new Family Regulations; **(iv)** successions interested by alien contractual schemes; **(v)** status filiations constituted abroad through a.r.t.; **(vi)** inheritance of digital goods;*
- 2. capacitate legal practitioners to correctly apply the Regulation.*

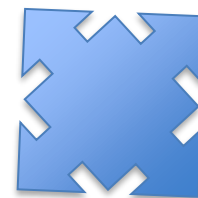
